

Vienna City Walking Tour

When visiting Vienna for the first time this tour is an excellent way to be introduced to the history and the most important buildings of the former imperial capital.

Along the way you will pass by the City Hall, continuing via the Volksgarten to Heldenplatz and enter the Hofburg Imperial Palace complex. Formerly the residence of the Habsburg rulers, it now houses the National Library, the Spanish Riding School, the Treasury, the Imperial Silver Collection, the Imperial Apartments and the Sisi Museum. Continue via Michaelerplatz where Roman excavations can be found and the Michaeler Kirche. Stroll along the elegant shopping street Kohlmarkt, with its famous coffee shop Demel. One of the most remarkable streets in Vienna's first district is the Graben, with its impressive facades and the plague monument. The last highlight of this city tour is the gothic cathedral, Stephansdom, in the very centre of Vienna. The tour will visit the cathedral and its catacombs and ends there.
